

CREDIT/NO CREDIT INFORMATION

If you need to take courses in order to fulfill your Distribution Requirements (1.0 credit in Science, 1.0 credit in Social Science, and 1.0 credit in Humanities within the minimum 20.0 credits required for your degree) and feel like one of the courses is not your strong suit and may affect your CGPA, you are able to Credit/No Credit it.



- You can select up 2.0 credits to be considered for CR/NCR (you can make this request on ACORN)
- However these can only be used to fulfill Distribution Requirements but cannot be used on required courses for your degree
- The status of CR (Credit) will be given in place of a grade if the student gets a final mark of at least 50% and it will count as a credit towards your degree with NO EFFECT on the GPA
- The status NCR (No Credit) will be given to any grade below 50% and will not be counted towards your degree and will have NO EFFECT on the GPA

Things to Keep in Mind

- This option can be used in any year/level/course or campus
- This option cannot be used in a course where a student has committed academic offense
- “Some programs specify that courses with a grade of CR/NCR will not count as part of the 4.0 credits required for program entry. Program entry requirements are detailed in departmental listings in this calendar.”
